I have been given the task to accomplish some kind of failover using PIX firewall and 2 ISP's connections as follows:

Site A – 2 PIX 506E , 2ISP – 1LAN
 Site B, C, D, E, PIX 501 , 1ISP
 Site F – PIX 515, 1DMZ, 1ISP

SITE A PIX 1-----VPN-----SITE C PIX-----VPN SITE F PIX
(ISP1)-----VPN-----SITE D PIX-----VPN SITE F PIX
-----VPN-----SITE E PIX-----VPN SITE F PIX

-----VPN-----SITE B PIX-----VPN SITE F PIX
SITE A PIX 2-----VPN-----SITE C PIX-----VPN SITE F PIX
(ISP2)-----VPN-----SITE D PIX-----VPN SITE F PIX
-----VPN-----SITE E PIX-----VPN SITE F PIX

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My question is : is it possible to have 2 separate VPN connection to the same SITE (looking from B,C,D,E point of view – they would see the LAN behind SITE A using 2 separate IPSec tunnels)? Has anyone done or seen anything similar? Do you have a better plan using the given, options??
