

Re: Kerio Winroute Firewall Xroxy problem

Note that this problem was fixed about a month ago, in Kerio WinRoute Firewall 5.1.4, where the exposed data was replaced by the 'X' character. However, this still provided a little information about the user (proxy). So, in the most recent release, 5.1.7, all unusable HTTP headers are completely removed from the HTTP request.

We of course encourage all of our users to upgrade to the most recent release. Kerio WinRoute Firewall upgrades are painless --- just download the new version and install it over the old one.
