Tomcat Real Path Disclosure Vulnerability

SUMMARY

A security vulnerability in Tomcat allows remote attackers to determine the true path used by the remote web server. This would assist an attacker in better constructing more harmful attacks.

DETAILS

Vulnerable systems:

Tomcat version 4.0.1

Immune systems:

Tomcat version 3.2.3
