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Directory Traversal bug in QuickFront Webserver

SUMMARY

<<http://www.matriks.com/>> Quickfront "will help you to capture emails that flow through your organization. QuickFront offers you to do full text searches on all these mails and view them with your internet browser". A directory traversal vulnerability in the product allows remote attackers to view the content of files that reside outside the bounding HTML root directory.

DETAILS

Vulnerable systems:

* QuickFront web server version 1.0.0.189

When attacker sends a request to server in the following form:

[http:// server>../../../../boot.ini](http://server>../../../../boot.ini)

The server will return the boot.ini file.

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Solution:

Vendor was contacted on 11/03/2003. The solution is to install latest version 2002.0.02.0916.
