SUMMARY

<<http://myserverweb.sourceforge.net/>> myServer Web is a "free and easy to configure web server". The product contains a vulnerability that allows remote attackers to cause the server to crash by sending it a large amount of '/' (slashes) in the GET requests the attacker issues.

DETAILS

Vulnerable systems:

* myServer version 0.4.1

Exploit:
