<<http://www.bolintech.com/>> Dream FTP Server provides powerful, multi threaded and robust FTP server performance with a user-friendly and easy-of-use interfaces. The DreamFTP server suffers from a format string vulnerability in the USER command.

## DETAILS

Vulnerable Systems:

- \* DreamFTP Server version 1.02

When connecting to the FTP server and supplying %n%n%n for the username, the FTP server crashes.

Example:

```
C:\>ftp 192.168.1.101
```

Connected to 192.168.1.101.
