

# [NEWS] Lotus Domino Buffer Overflow (Time/Date Field)

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## SUMMARY

" <<http://www.lotus.com/products/product4.nsf/wdocs/dominohomepage>> IBM Lotus Domino server software combines enterprise-class messaging and calendar/ scheduling capabilities with a robust platform for collaborative applications on a wide variety of operating systems."

A buffer overflow vulnerability in Lotus Domino allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code on the server.

## DETAILS

Vulnerable Systems:

- \* Lotus Domino version 6.5.4
- \* Lotus Domino version 6.0.5

A buffer overflow vulnerability occurs whenever a user submits large amount of data to certain time/date fields that can be updated from the web interface. This vulnerability can be exploited by a malicious user with access to the web server to cause the Lotus Domino server to execute arbitrary code and to crash, resulting in a Denial of Server

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Vendor Status:

The vendor has issued a patch for both versions:
