> *The version of apache is 1.3.19.*

> *Is this the right version against the new apache worm ?*

> *Is this a special SuSE patched version ?*

> *Apachetoday.com means that I have to upgrade to 1.3.26 but there is only a package for 8.0.*

You don't need 1.3.26 so long as the patch was backported to the version you use. In the Red Hat world we're still on 1.3.23, but the latest RPM includes a patch for the chunky exploit. It appears that SuSE has done the same.
