>Is PAM fully functional in Solaris 2.5.1?

No, PAM did not exist as a public interface until Solaris 2.6

>I can find all the shared libraries but no pam.conf file.

Correct everything was hard coded in 2.5.1.

>I am trying to install openssh and need to know if i can use the flag

>--with-pam, smae goes for openssl.

No you can't. I'd strongly suggest upgrading to something more recent than 2.5.1.

I don't believe there is anything in OpenSSL that uses PAM, since OpenSSL is about crypto algorithms and the SSL protocol. I could be wrong though, if so please point me to the bit in OpenSSL that uses PAM so I can verify that it does so correctly.
