Is there any way to limit which hosts can access a given map from NIS? Like, say we want to have server A have access to map B, but we dont want server C to see map B. Is that possible? Is it possible with NIS+? Basically, what I'm driving at is whether it would be possible to have a DMZ server part of the NIS domain, so it can use NIS/NIS+ to do hostname lookups, etc. but not to see the passwd map or what have you. (or just prevent it from ypcat'ing the passwd map)
