We have about 800 /22 and /24 subnets, and because of the IP addressing scheme in place, might just be easier for me to scan the whole class A range of IP's.

I have access to Nessus and GFI Security Scanner. Since we over 8000 IP's in place, does anyone have any advice on the best way to identify these non Cisco AP's such as Linksys and Netgear, etc.
