Spybot search and destroy is preventing an attempted hijack of my google toolbar and/or home page. Because I told Spybot search and destroy to remember that I didn't want the global browser toolbar @ 2318CB1=4965-11d49818-009027 AF CD4F changed, it in a loop trying to make the change. I assume that if I uninstall Spybot the infiltrator will go ahead and change the toolbar. It may then be difficult to get their stuff off as it is so persistent in wanting on. Can anyone advise me what to do?
