> *ls /proc |grep 14984*

not listed...

> *If it is not listed, but if the command ls /proc/14984 does return*
> *results, it does not smell good.*

it does return results...

> *If checkrootkit says you are infected with "SIGINVISIBLE Adore"*
> *you should double-check with rootkit-hunter www.rootkit.nl*

This one doesn't find any trojan, just some vulnerable applications like gpg... :)

And there are no suspicious logs or other abnormal server activities, so I'm quite sure it is clean.
