>> authorized to view this page" messages. Do you have the Privacy  
Alert  
>> popup enabled? It will tell you what it is blocking on a given  
page.  
>> I have ZAP, though, and I don't know if the Free version has these  
>> options in your case. Maybe you should visit the Forum and search  
for  
>> messages about the yEnc problem. I remember seeing some a while  
ago.
