I have symantec 10.2 and symantec for exchange and a barracuda on the outside of my network. Can any one help to find the root of this issue. I use the normal tools like rootkit revealer and aports for scanning my ports but still they get in. I check my server a few times a day and usually I catch it within a day but that might be to late. My updates and patches are up to date. I am running SBS 2003 sp2 and exchange 2003 sp1.

Ok, and where's the question? Or the problem? Or the news? Since you don't do anything serious to recover from the compromise, such a sequence of events is reasonably expected.
