Hello !

I have a mandrake 9.0 computer working as gateway / firewall and I try to nonnect to it from another computer under mandrake 9.0 on my NAT. The name of the user is "slasher" and he's exist on the two computer. I have created the key on the 2nd computer with `ssh-keygen -N...` and copied the `id_rsa.pub` file to the `/home/slasher/.ssh/authorized_keys` of the 1st computer. I have also modified the `StrictMode` line of `/etc/ssh/sshd_config` to "no". I have authorized the ssh connection on the firewall...

I login to "slasher" user on the second computer and type "`ssh 192.168.1.1`" (192.168.1.1 is the local IP of the 1st computer) and I have the following message : "`ssh_exchange_identification: Connection closed by remote host`"
