>> *If you are using dynamic openssl libraries, then you should only  
>> need to rebuild those without recompiling openssh.*

>*That's what I thought. And then I found out that libcrypto's soname  
>is 0.9.7 (old one had 0.9.6). So you can't upgrade from 0.9.6x to  
>0.9.7y without rebuilding openssh and everything else linked with  
>openssl's so's.*

My comment was specifically about applying the patches posted at the openssl site, and then recompiling. The version number does not change with that.

When I went from 0.9.6g to 0.9.7, I did recompile everything that uses openssl.
