I have a firewall currently that has a built-in X gateway, my corporate IT department has mandated I use a PIX firewall which does not have X gateway support so I figured I'd go with ssh. I have one application that I cannot get to work through an ssh X tunnel. It is called STP (Software through pictures) and it is very old and there is no support for it that I can find, but enough background here is the error I get:

I do have X forwarding turned on (on both server and client) as an xterm and other X apps come through fine. and ssh -V produces the following output:
