- > *But when I log out from the remote machine, ssh still does not close.*
- > *There is not remote X program running to hold the connection open, but*
- > *it refuses to shut down the X connection.*

I've seen that too. Try running 'ssh -v' to make it more verbose. A quick fix: enter, tilde, ampersand will background the SSH session and let it close on it's own.
