Hello,

this might be a strange question, but I am collecting information for how much work do I have to expect to implement (just) sftp. I don't need port-forwarding and so on. For hashing and encryption I'll use a library (cryptlib).

Unfortunately I can't use the session management of the cryptlib because I want to use the whole ssh2/sftp stuff in a kernel mode driver and connections to a remote machine is different in kernel mode.

I already looked at <http://www.ietf.org/internet-drafts/> but I am unable to guess how long it would take to implement ssh2/sftp.

Has anyone already some experience? Or can you guess how it would take? :) Maybe someone point me to some more information on the internet...
