Which could of course be on an NFS server, but I suppose you're saying that it's not.

> *debug1: Trying private key: /home/robert/.ssh2/identification*
> *debug1: PEM_read_PrivateKey failed*
> *debug1: read PEM private key done: type <unknown>*

Are you sure you really have a `.ssh2/identification` file (instead of a `.ssh2/identity` file)? Why are you specifying that on the command line explicitly instead of just letting it use the defaults?
