I am working on the middle tier of an enterprise application, and am embedding security checking in it. I am trying to use the following snippet of code to check to see if the currently logged-on user is in the group ArtUser. I have tried putting the domain in front of the group name (DOMAIN\ArtUser) and that didn't work. I can make this code work just fine if I use one of the BUILTIN groups like BUILTIN\Users, and it works fine using Name := and the user's name. Can anyone help me out with this? Am I missing something that is just blatantly obvious?
