This code:

Private Shared FileLockMutex As System.Threading.Mutex
Shared Sub New()
    FileLockMutex = New System.Threading.Mutex(False,
"MyFileLockMutex")
End Sub
```

on an aspx page produces the following error message on one server I host on.
