If you have no certificates installed on the client machine, or there are no certificates issued by CA's that the server trusts, then you wont be prompted.

Make sure you have a client certificate installed in IE for the user who is accessing the site, and preferably have it issued by the same CA that issued the server's cert. (This last step isn't necessary, but just makes life easier during testing)

Hope that helps.
