This is fairly difficult to do.

Do you want to prevent someone sharing a login? Or do you want to prevent concurrent logins? The former is quite difficult to do – and it's a problem that afflicts any authentication scheme, anyone can turn a private key into a shared key. You could require users to use biometric identification or similar, as that is difficult to share.
