

WindowsPrincipal.IsInRole() problem with non-builtin roles

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Can't get WindowsPrincipal.IsInRole() to work for me when using Windows Authentication. Here's a snippet of code from my C# codebehind page:

```
WindowsPrincipal wp = new WindowsPrincipal(
WindowsIdentity.GetCurrent() );
lblUser.Text = wp.Identity.Name;
Label1.Text = wp.IsInRole(@"DOMAIN\group").ToString();
```

where "DOMAIN\group" is a valid group name. The username shows up correctly as "DOMAIN\username" but for any non-builtin roles, IsInRole() returns false. Does anyone have suggestions as to why this is not working?

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
