Administrators is one of the special BUILTIN Group. It is like a localized kind of special domain. On your web server it is most likely added to the users session token when authenticated against IIS because the user is a member of your USA\Domain Admins group which has been added to your Web Servers BUILTIN\Administrators group. If that is the case then use:

```
User.IsInRole("BUILTIN\Administrators")
```

In C#

```
User.IsInRole(@"BUILTIN\Administrators")
```

Or you can use `User.IsInRole("USA\Domain Admins")`.

But there is no USA\Administrators group available at the web server.
