Hello Tdar,

By default, an ASP.NET application will use a database file "ASPNETDB.MDF" in the folder "app\_data" to save information about roles and users. (You may attach this file in SQL Server 2005 to see its details). For example, there are two tables in the database: "aspnet\_Applications" and "aspnet\_Users". Table "aspnet\_Applications" contains the "ApplicationName" and "ApplicationID"; Table "aspnet\_Users" contains "ApplicationID" and user information.

To deploy an ASP.NET 2.0 project, you can deploy the database together so that you don't need to create users and roles again,
