Hello Ryan,

The article is only part of the whole solution, it also refer another article: How to: Sample Membership Provider Implementation(<http://msdn2.microsoft.com/en-us/library/6tc47t75.aspx>). It uses totally different data source than original ASPNETSQLmembership provider. So, it didn't add two customized fields, it created a brand new table to save all the required fields:
