Hi All,

I create an intranet web application using asp.net 2.0.

I set the authentication mode="Windows" in the web.config, and set IIS as NT Authentication and uncheck the anonymous login box.

If I run on my local machine, the NT Windows dialog box login will not popup, but I still get the "Domain/UserName",. Now I put that web application on the production server then the NT Windows Login dialog box will popup to ask the users for their username and password. Is there a way to disable this box to popup, but I still get the Domain/UserName.

I read some article, it tell me to set the "Domain/UserName" or Domain/Group user in the production server where the application run, then the NT Windows Login dialog box will not popup. Is that true? If it is true, then how do I set that up.
