Because you have unchecked "allow anonymous access", all the stuff you have done creating the IUSR accounts etc is not currently working. Renable anonymous access and it should probably work.

At the moment, the webpages are using the user's NT credentials, however unless you enable delegation, the webserver is unable to pass these credentials to the machine running SQL Server.

Renable anonymous authentication if you want the IUSR_<machine> account to be used to access the remote SQL Server.
