I am trying to set up a FTP server through windows XP pro. I am using a dynamic dns client (no-ip.com). I am using port 8181 to set up the FTP server. I have anonymous access disabled, so only the administrator can log onto the ftp server. I have shared the ftp folder in the intepub directory. When I try to connect to the ftp server in WS_FTP LE, I get the following error message
