I'm having problems setting up permission for script folders in my IIS 4/WinNT server.

My web site is structured like this:

\Root\

\Root\Scripts\

\Root\Scripts\App1

\Root\Scripts\App2

\Root\Scripts\AppX

Each App1..AppX is configured as an isolated process (to unload each one separately).

The problem is that when I allow a new user to access some of this folders (via WinNT folder permissions and User Manager) that user can't access it!. Sometimes after a while, or after I restart the server, the access is granted. I also tried unloading the apps but nothing happened.

My questions are: Is this normal? do I always have to wait for permissions to be working? Am I doing something wrong?
