> *My ASP code looks like this:*

> *Set enm = Server.CreateObject("adodb.connection")*

> *enm.Open "Driver={SQL*

> *Server};Server=SERVER;Trusted_Connection=yes;Database=Northwind;"*

You should use the native OLE DB provider, not ODBC:

```
enm.open "provider=sqloledb;Integrated Security=SSPI;" & _  
"Data Source=SERVER;Initial Catalog=Northwind"
```

> *Set rsUser = enm.Execute("SELECT * FROM customers")*

> *Set enm = Nothing*

> *I get the Error on the .Execute*

>

On the Execute? If it was a problem with the connection itself, the Open statement would be throwing the error, not the Execute.

What is the error?
