I have a web app that receives XML, parses it, runs it against a database, then sends this data back as XML.

When the file is received, a corresponding text file that contains the data being received is created in a virtual directory.

This configuration runs fine in IIS 5.1 on XP Pro. But in the production environment (Windows 2003 and IIS 6.0) the text files are not getting created.

I have gone so far as to grant IUSR_machinename administrative permissions on this Virtual directory (full control), but still no text files are being written.

What permissions are needed to allow these text files to be created in the Virtual directory?
