| have the correct digital ID, etc. I would prefer to show a custom message
| that details how to obtain the correct digital ID. Does anyone know how to
| include inside an email a message that will be shown in Outlook/Outlook
| Express in the case of a decryption failure in a manner similar to
| multipart/alternative for text/HTML email?
