>Update Catalog, which lets you store fixes locally for subsequent

>installation. To access this catalog, perform the following steps:

>Go to the general Windows Update Web site.

>Under Other Options, select Personalize Windows Update.

>Select the "Display the link to the Windows Update Catalog under See Also"

>option.

>Click Save Settings.

>Under See Also, you will now have Windows Update Catalog.

>You can also access the corporate Windows Update Catalog directly at this

>Microsoft Web site. After you access the catalog, you can add several fixes

>to your "basket" that Windows Update will download to your machine.
