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1) Download the following three items...

Trend Sysclean Package

<http://www.trendmicro.com/download/dcs.asp>

Latest Trend signature files.

<http://www.trendmicro.com/download/pattern.asp>

Adaware SE

<http://www.lavasoftusa.com/>

Create a directory.

On drive "C:"

(e.g., "c:\New Folder")

or the desktop

(e.g., "C:\Documents and Settings\lipman\Desktop\New Folder")

Download sysclean.com and place it in that directory.

Download the signature files (pattern files) by obtaining the ZIP file.

For example; lpt186.zip

Extract the contents of the ZIP file and place the contents in the same directory as sysclean.com.

- 2) If you are using WinME or WinXP, disable System Restore  
<http://vil.nai.com/vil/SystemHelpDocs/DisableSysRestore.htm>
- 3) Reboot your PC into Safe Mode
- 4) Using both the Trend Sysclean utility and Adaware, perform a Full Scan of your platform and clean/delete any infectors/parasites found.
- 5) Restart your PC and perform a "final" Full Scan of your platform using both the Trend Sysclean utility and Adaware
- 6) If you are using WinME or WinXP, Re-enable System Restore and re-apply any System Restore preferences, (e.g. HD space to use suggested 400 ~ 600MB),
- 7) Reboot your PC.
- 8) If you are using WinME or WinXP, create a new Restore point
- 9) Please report back your results
