| All originate @ C:/windows/system32/hpAF79.tmp and are infected by the
| Puper.dll trojan

| A different location comes up each time so I have restarted my pc several
| times but it still appears.

| I have downloaded microsoft anti spyware and it tells me my system has no
| problems.

| I tried to quarantine and delete the infected file but it tells me it is
| being used by another programme and can't be deleted.

| What can I do to get rid of this peskie trojan. Help appreciated.

Scott:

Download and execute the following Multi AV scanning tool.

>From the menu, choose; "3. McAfee" and download the needed files. When it asks if you
want to perform a scan now, indicate no.

You will be brought back to the menu. Choose; "5. Reboot the PC" and when the PC begins
to restart, hit the F8 key and start in Safe Mode.

Re-run the utility and choose; "3. McAfee" and scan the computer.

It is a self-extracting ZIP file that contains the Kixtart Script Interpreter { <http://kixtart.org> Kixtart is CareWare } three batch files, five Kixtart scripts, one Link (.LNK) file, a PDF instruction file and two utilities; UNZIP.EXE and WGET.EXE. It will simplify the process of using; Sophos, Trend and McAfee Anti Virus Command Line Scanners to remove viruses, Trojans and various other malware.

C:\AV-CLS\StartMenu.BAT -- { or Double-click on 'Start Menu' in C:\AV-CLS }
This will bring up the initial menu of choices and should be executed in Normal Mode. This way all the components can be downloaded from each AV vendor's web site.
The choices are; Sophos, Trend, McAfee, Exit the menu and Reboot the PC.

You can choose to go to each menu item and just download the needed files or you can download the files and perform a scan in Normal Mode. Once you have downloaded the files needed for each scanner you want to use, you should reboot the PC into Safe Mode [F8 key during boot] and re-run the menu again and choose which scanner you want to run in Safe Mode. It is suggested to run the scanners in both Safe Mode and Normal Mode.

When the menu is displayed hitting 'H' or 'h' will bring up a more comprehensive PDF help file.

To use this utility, perform the following...

Execute; Multi_AV.exe { Note: You must use the default folder C:\AV-CLS }
Choose; Unzip
Choose; Close

Execute; C:\AV-CLS\StartMenu.BAT
{ or Double-click on 'Start Menu' in C:\AV-CLS }

NOTE: You may have to disable your software FireWall or allow WGET.EXE to go through your FireWall to allow it to download the needed AV vendor related files.
