1. Download and execute HiJack This! (HJT)
http://www.trendsecure.com/portal/en-US/threat_analytics/HJTInstall.exe
2. Disable Notepad's word wrap:
In Notepad.exe; Format --> uncheck; "Word wrap"
3. Download/run Deckard's System Scanner:
<http://www.techsupportforum.com/sectools/Deckard/dss.exe>
4. Save the scan results (Main.txt and Extra.txt)
5. And then post the contents of Main.txt and Extra.txt in your post in one of the below expert forums...
