If the four-part naming convention does not work, you can utilize 'OPENQUERY'. Or you can try to change the four-part query to upper case instead of lower case and it probably works. From Q248062: When using SQL linked Server queries with a four part name to access mixed-case tables in Oracle (created without using quotes), users will need to access it using upper case letters, from SQL Server, such as:

Select * from OracleServer..DEMO.SQLCUST
