I've seen posts on this problem before when lightweight pooling was enabled. If you have it enabled, go back to the default setting of 0 using sp\_configure.

You need to restart the service for the setting to take effect. For more info, see lightweight pooling in books online.

I think you could also hit the problem if the mail profile for SQL Agent is messed up. In that case, you could try removing the mail profile from SQL Agent properties and start up the service and see if that corrects the problem.
