You need to grant the users permissions to objects in a database – objects such as tables, views, stored procedures, user defined functions. You really would want to review the security topics in books online in order to be able to manager this. I don't think it can be fully explained in a newsgroup post. If you go into SQL Server books online, under Administering SQL Server, there is a subtopic called Managing Security. You will want to read through that to get an understanding of how SQL Server security works.
