Michael,

I know this isn't a lot of help, but Query Analyzer connects to SQL Server via ODBC, so I doubt very much whether this is an ODBC issue.

My best guess, is that your application ODBC connection string is using Windows Authentication, and so is connecting as you, and your permissions, rather than that of the user that you are trying to impersonate.
