Hi there.

I am looking for a way to log details of all logins/logouts for an SQL 2000 Server. So far, I've come across using the 'Security' tab in the database 'properties' dialog (Enterprise Mgr – right-click on the database..) to enable "Audit ALL".

This allows me to view logins & logouts in the Server logs (under the 'Management' tree). Unfortunately, I can't get enough information from this:

–The log records only show a user name for the events – I don't know how to find out how the IPAddress or any more information on the login.

Any ideas where I might find such info?

Basically, user name isn't enough to identify applications for me because the applications I'm looking for all use the same one.

Any help would be appreciated!
