- b. Audit Logout

2. In the data columns select

- a. Loginname
- b. start time
- c. databasename

3. In the filter set a filter to databasename u need to audit.

Incase u need to audit all the activities u can use C2 Audit feature in SQL 2000 using sp_configure.
