Following Microsoft recommendations, I'd like to store a one-way passport hash of a user's password. .NET provides method `FormsAuthentication.HashPasswordForStoringInConfigFile(...)` to generate a hash value with either SHA1 or MD5 algorithm. My problem is that the password is to be generated on a workstation with no .NET installed. How can I generate a hash value without .NET in the same way as `HashPasswordForStoringInConfigFile` does? Is there any sequence of Windows Crypto API calls with the same effect? An external stored procedure on the server side?
