I need to find the owner of jobs and stored procedures that have been created and change all of them to be owned by sa. I have recently been getting a randomly occurring error in some job execution due to SQL not being able to verify if an object owner really has access.

This the notification message I receive:

STATUS: Failed

MESSAGES: The job failed. Unable to determine if the owner (NCN\dbohannon) of job Restore DukeEDI_TLog has server access (reason: Could not obtain information about Windows NT group/user 'NCN\dbohannon'. [SQLSTATE 42000] (Error 8198)).

I don't understand what would cause this since my account is a sysadmin and it is the same security that these jobs have always run under.
