>Hello.

>

>Here is my problem.

>I have a CSV file on a server, let's say "server1".

>I have also a stored procedure, into a SQL Server database, which is located

>on another server, let's say "server2".

>These 2 servers are in the same network.

>

>I need to connect from the stored procedure to the CSV file, using

>OPENDATASOURCE, like this:

>OPENDATASOURCE("Microsoft.Jet.OLEDB.4.0","Data

>Source=\\Idd1\test_files_import\1_files;Extended

>Properties="text;HDR=Yes;FMT=Delimited"...CLASSES#CSV

>It gives the following error:

>

>Microsoft OLE DB Provider for SQL Server error '80040e14'

>\test_files_import\1_files' is not

>a valid path. Make sure that the path name is spelled correctly and that you

>are connected to the server on which the file resides.]
